

Minutes of the Bloomington Township Board

The meeting was called to order at 4:37 p.m. on August 10, 2023.

Board members present were Dorothy Granger, Barbara E. McKinney, and E. Sensenstein. Also present were Deputy Trustee Lisa Myers and, via Zoom, Trustee Efrat Rosser.

AGENDA

Barbara moved to accept the agenda as presented. E seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

Barbara moved to accept the minutes of the July 20, 2023, board meeting as presented. E seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

2024 Budget: Lisa explained the new budget handouts, which include an increase of \$7000 to cover the cost of an annual mailing to township residents. Dorothy asked if funding was included to cover the cost of a generator for the office. Lisa reported that we are working to obtain an estimate as we believe we have sufficient funds in the current budget to cover the purchase. The dates for upcoming budget procedures were reviewed

NEW BUSINESS

Community Kitchen Capital Improvement: Efrat directed attention to Community Kitchen's letter requesting financial support for their capital improvement plan for CK Express. Discussion ensued. Barbara moved to grant \$50,000 to Community Kitchen. E seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

REPORTS

Trustee:

Efrat reported that we have been working with the residents who were displaced by the fire at Kinser Flats. Staff has been working with the families to assist in finding temporary housing since most hotels are booked for the IU move-in period. Hayes Gibson, the property management company, stated that if we could get the residents through the upcoming weekend, they have a plan in place for the following week. Some units were expected to be repaired by the end of the weekend.

A bid has been awarded for the fence replacement at Griffith Cemetery. Materials are on order and the fence will be installed in the coming weeks.
