The meeting was called to order at 4:32 p.m. on November 13, 2025.

Board members present were E. Sensenstein and Barbara E. McKinney. Dorothy Granger attended via Zoom. Also present were Trustee Efrat Rosser and Deputy Trustee Lisa Myers.

AGENDA

NEW BUSINESS

Nepotism Certifications: Lisa distributed and discussed the nepotism certificates. These certificates confirm that no employees of the township or any companies contracted by the township are related to the elected official who signs the certificate. The Trustee and each board member signed the certification for each classification.

2026 Meeting Schedule: The proposed meeting schedule was distributed. After discussion, the decision was made to move the board meeting start time to noon for 2026.

Trustee Efrat provided an update on food pantry traffic, noting that the numbers for the first week of November are three times higher compared to the same period in 2024.

Efrat reported that Sarah Grace, Housing Case Manager for Heading Home, has begun working with us. Sarah is currently on-site two days each week and is working out of Perry Township on the remaining days.


Efrat announced that we are providing a grant to the Monroe Fire Protection District for equipment that will be used at the fire station in Bloomington Township.
