

## **Minutes of the Bloomington Township Board**

The meeting was called to order at 12:08 p.m. on February 12, 2026.

Board members present were Barbara E. McKinney and E. Sensenstein. Also present were Trustee Efrat Rosser and Deputy Trustee Lisa Myers.

### **AGENDA**

Barbara moved to accept the agenda as presented. E. seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

### **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES**

Barbara moved to accept the minutes of the January 12, 2026, board meeting as presented. E. seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Annual Financial Report:** The 2025 Annual Report for Bloomington Township was presented. This report includes the financial data from the previous year, along with the “TA-7,” which is the township assistance statistical report. After discussion, Barbara moved to approve the 2025 Annual Report, and E. seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The report will be published in the Herald Times on Thursday, February 26, 2026.

**Investment Policy:** Lisa explained that the previous policy expired in 2025, and a new investment policy is needed as a formality. It was confirmed that the Township currently has two (2) 5-month certificates of deposit (CDs). Barbara moved to approve the policy as presented. E. seconded, motion passed unanimously.

**Secondary Employment:** Lisa reported that there are no employees with secondary employment at this time, so no further action is needed.

**Township Assistance Guidelines Draft:** Efrat highlighted some minor changes to the guidelines. The only significant change pertains to the office hours of the township; most other adjustments have been made for clarification or reorganization. No action is required at this time, and the guidelines will be submitted for approval at the March meeting.

### **REPORTS**

**Trustee:** Efrat provided updates on legislation concerning two township reorganization bills introduced this year. Both SB270 and HB1315 have passed through their original chambers and are now in the opposing chamber.

Efrat also reported that planning is underway for our next special event. A spring theme is planned, although the date and specific details are still being finalized.
